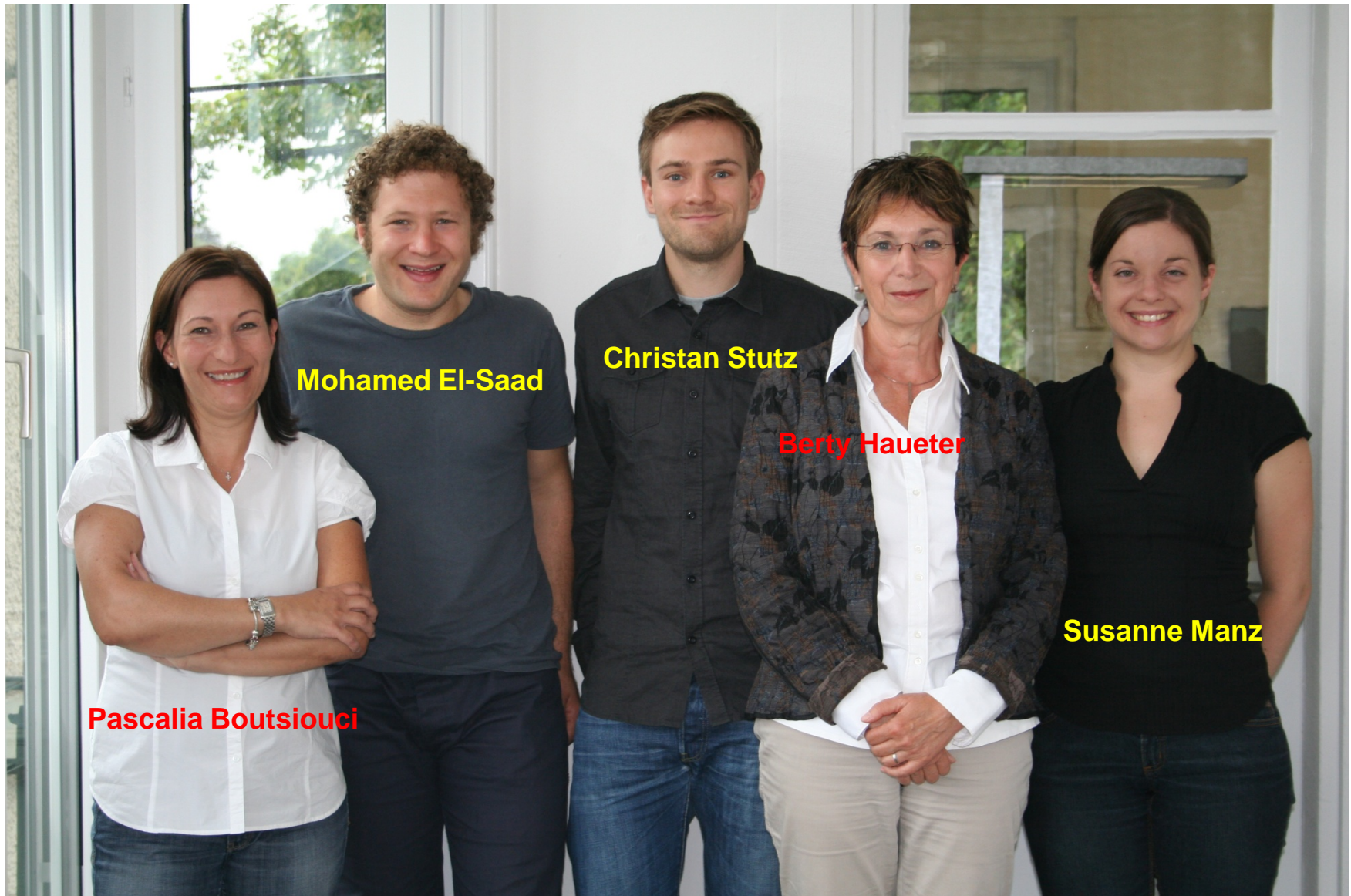

→ Cooperation with about 40 publishers/content providers

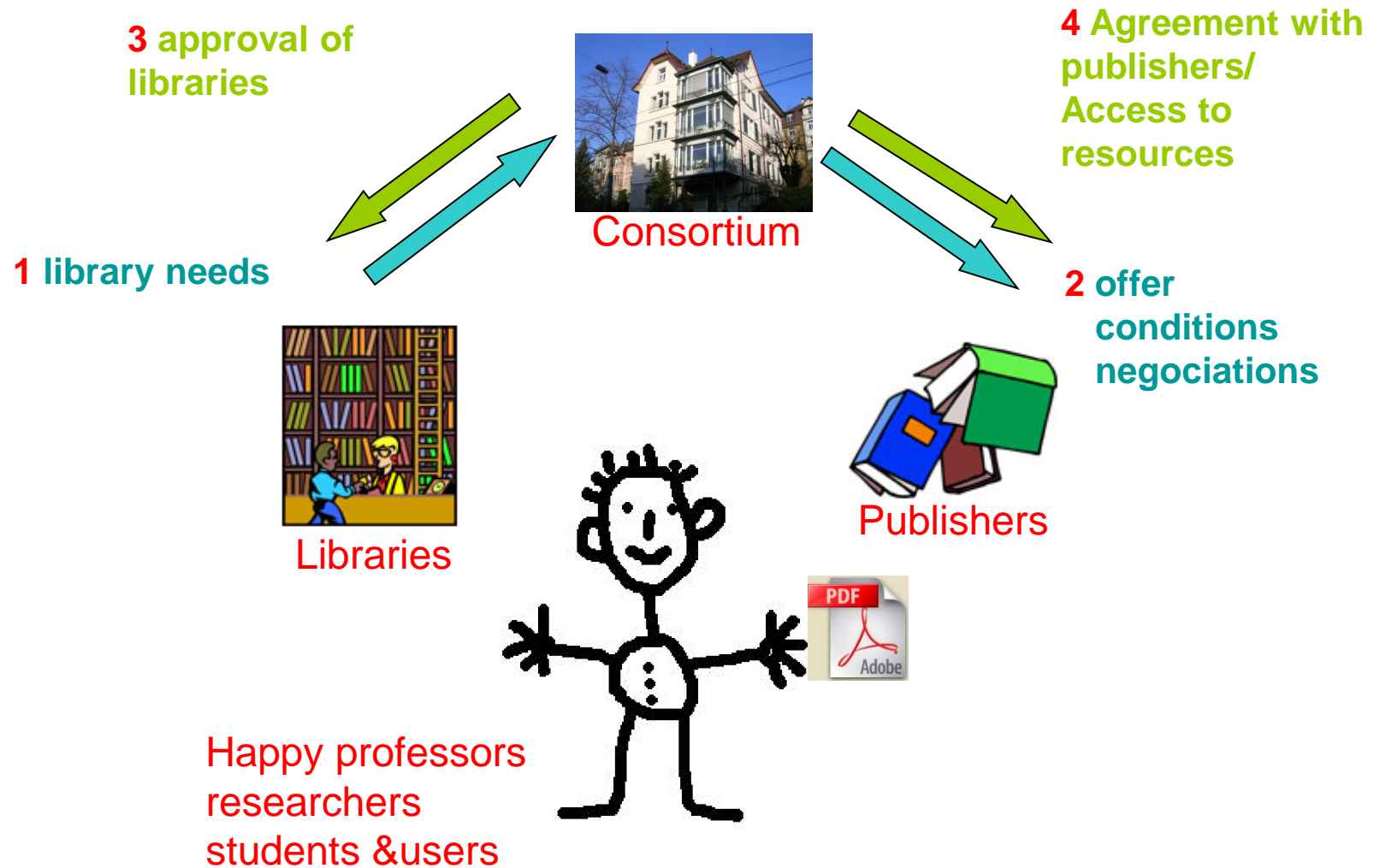
## ► Negotiations

- Annual survey
  - Determining the needs, requirements and wishes of the member libraries
- Getting quotes from publishers
- Organising product tests for libraries
- Start negotiations for licence agreement
- Consortium enters into an agreement with publishers if conditions are favourable for its members

## ■ After Agreement

- Fees are invoiced to libraries
  - Via SWETS (subscription services company)
- Acces to content
  - Organised by the consortium
  - Consortium helpdesk for access problems

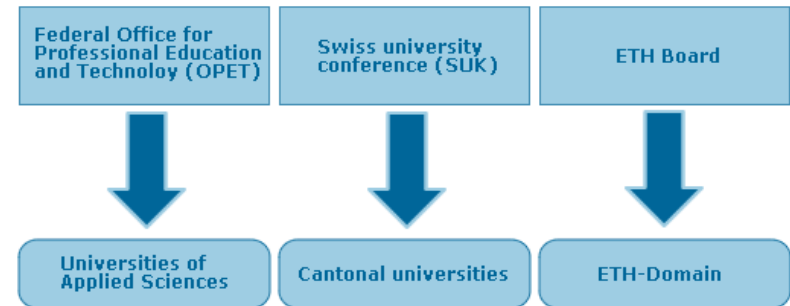
# Projects

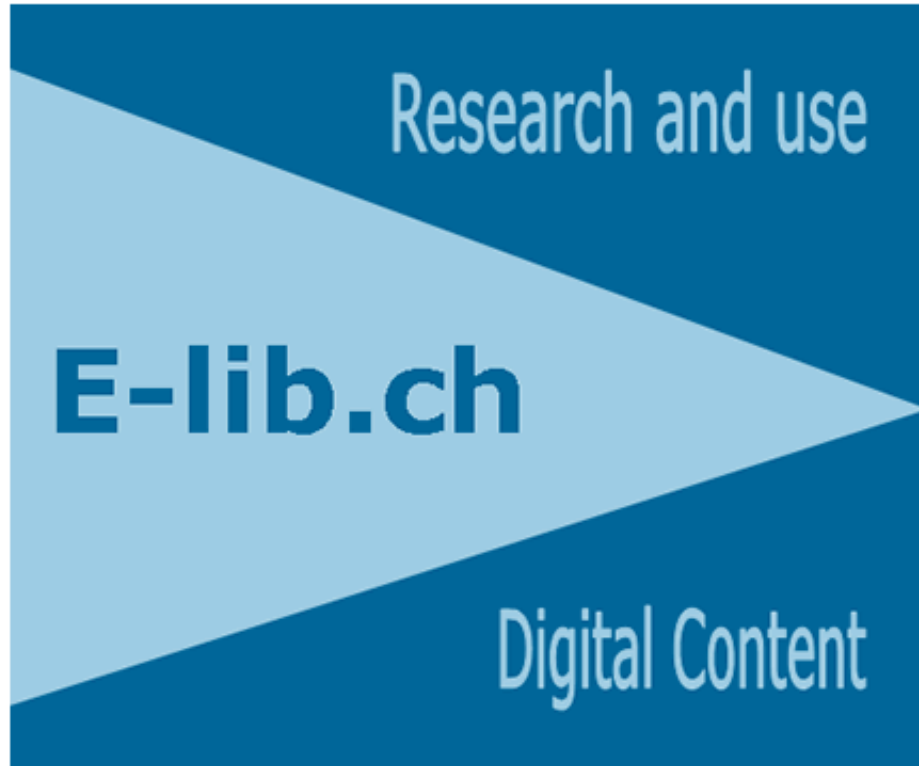

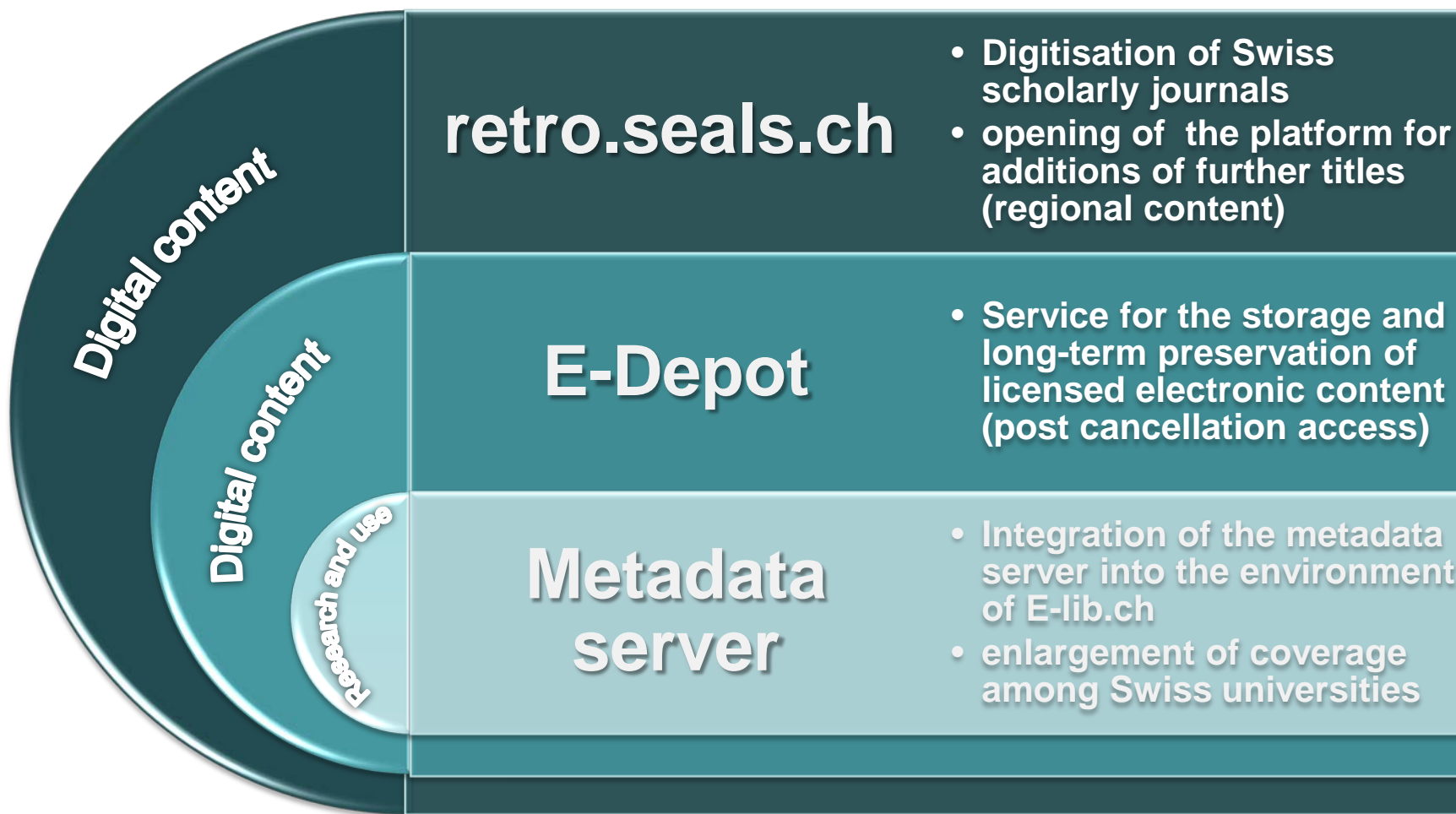

## Ein Doppelwohnhaus am Zürich- berg.

„Die Traulichkeit, die früher, und zwar in den verschiedensten Stilzeiten, so sehr den Grundzug des bürgerlichen Hausbaues ausmachte, daß die ganze Erscheinung des Hauses auch nach außen hin erwärmend von ihr durchdrungen war“, versuchen die Architekten unserer Zeit für ihre Schöpfungen zurückzugewinnen.

Es hat lange gedauert, bis man die so einfachen Mittel entdeckte, die den alten Bauwerken ihre heimelige Gemütlichkeit verleihen. Nachdem man aber erkannt hatte, daß neben der Vermeidung aller unzumutbaren Zierden und neben einer geschmackvollen Verwendung der Farbe, vor allem das feile Dach mit fei-

nehmende Privatkultur unserer Zeit, welche die Selbstständigkeit des freien Menschen mit der Dankbarkeit gegenüber der Tradition vereinigt!

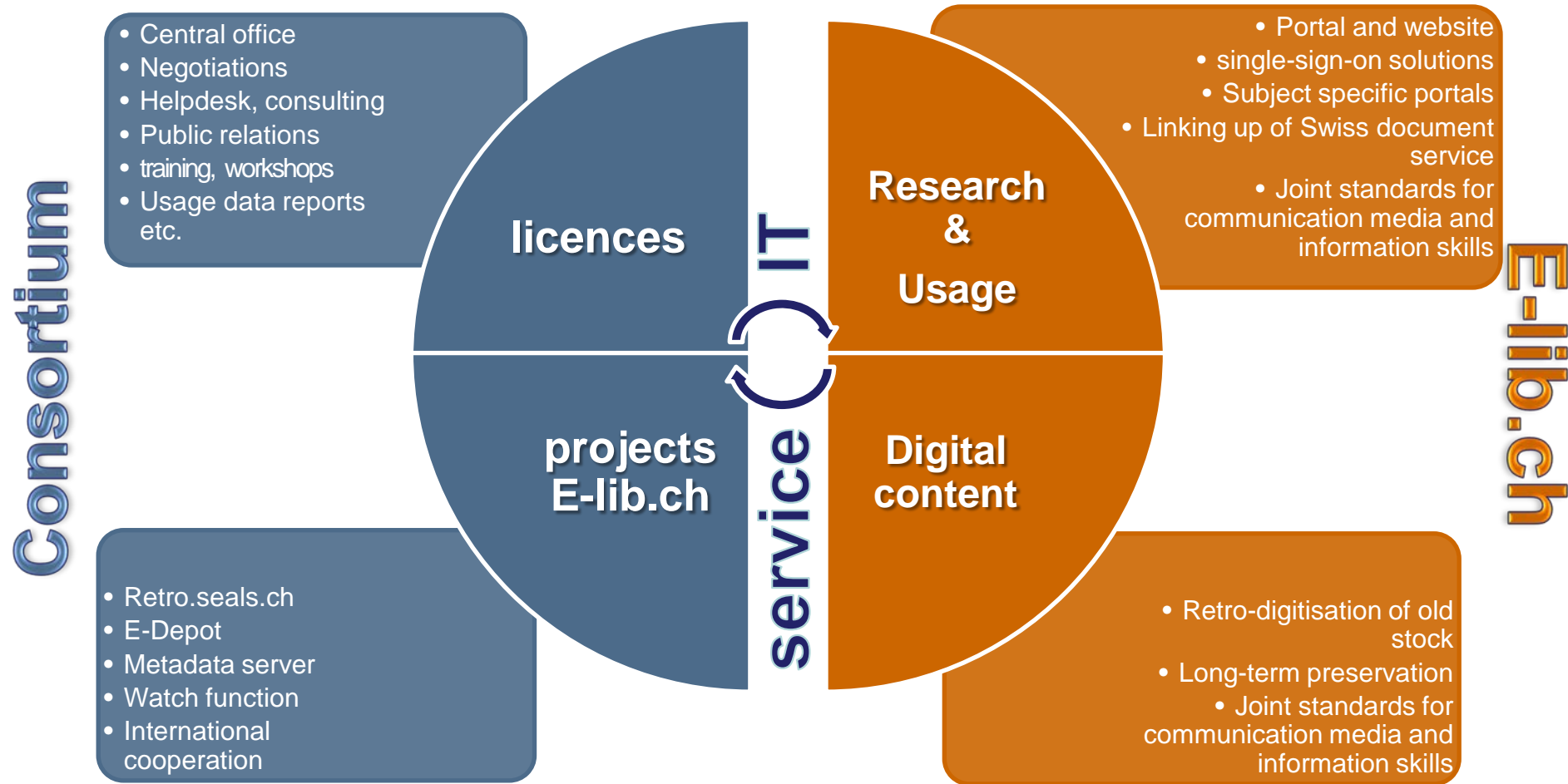
Solch ein trauliches, zeitgemäßes Haus ist das Doppelwohnhaus, das Architekt Armin Witmer-Karrer in Zürich am Abhang des Zürichberges erbaut hat. Mit mög-

lichst geringem Kostenaufwand sollten für zwei Familien heizungsmäßige, praktisch ausgestattete Wohnungen geschaffen werden mit kleinen Hausgärten und reichlichen Nebenräumen. Das ist trefflich gelungen. Wie die Grundrisse zeigen, sind die Zimmer geräumig und geschickt gruppiert, die Vorräume weit und die Treppen zweckentsprechend angeordnet. Der Innenaussattung ist besondere Sorgfalt gewidmet worden. Gut zueinander abgestimmte Tapeten und Konterbehnungen

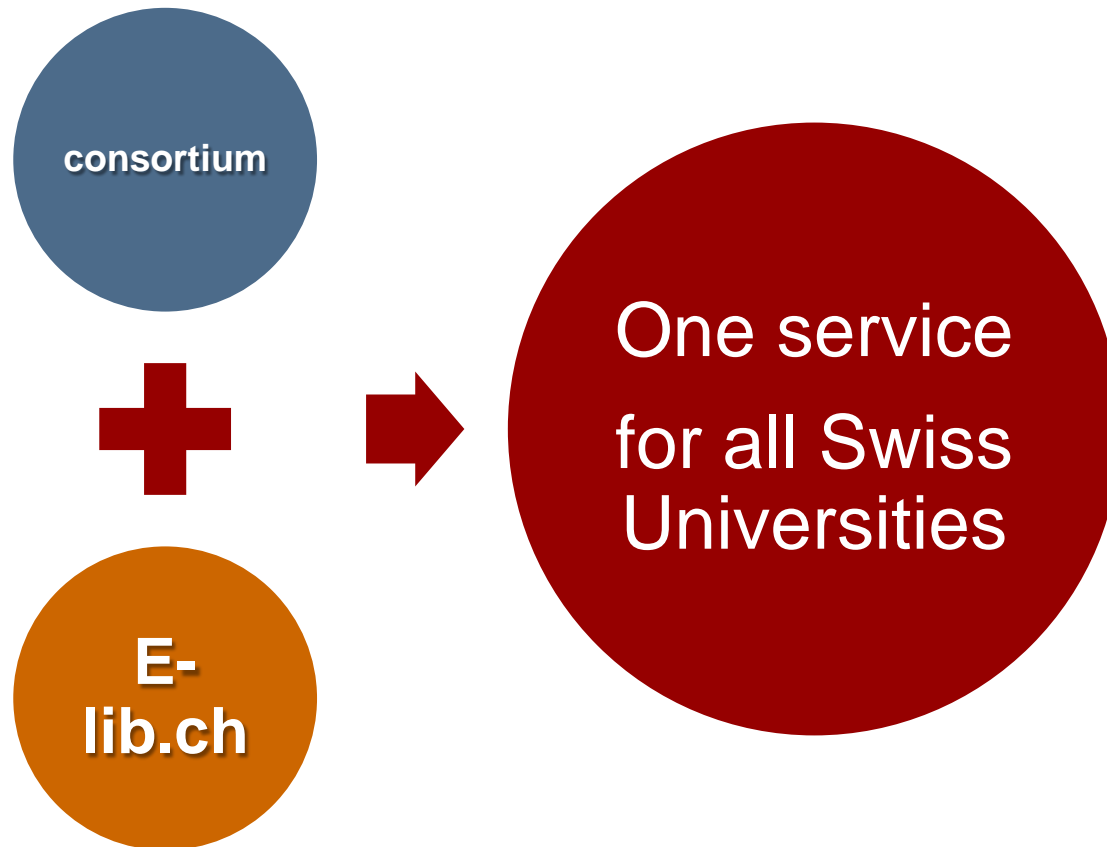


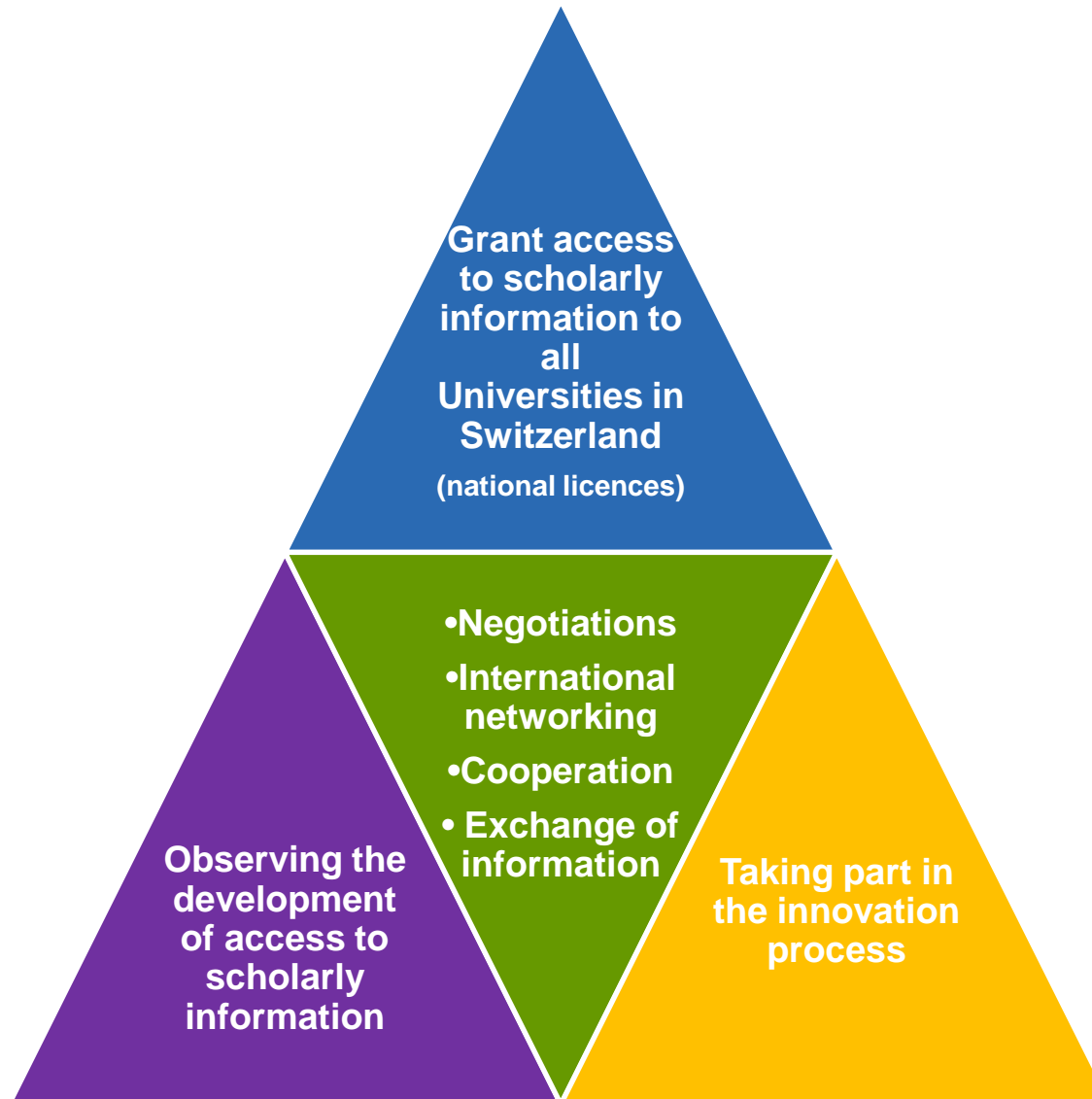
