 - → 0.7 FTE financed via the consortium





For libraries

- Saving for licences due to centrally managed negotiations
- One licence agreement
- Know-how and technical support for access problems
- Consulting service
- Usage statistics
- Dealing with current issues (e-books, ERM-systems, national licences etc.)
- Training courses, workshops, information sessions

NEGOTIATION OF LICENCES (A)

Negotiations


- Annual survey
 - Determining the needs, requirements and wishes of the member libraries
- Getting quotes from publishers
- Organising product tests for libraries
- Start negotiations for licence agreement
- Consortium enters into an agreement with publishers if conditions are favourable for its members

NEGOTIATION OF LICENCES (B)

After Agreement

- Fees are invoiced to libraries
 - Via SWETS (subscription services company)
- Acces to content
 - Organised by the consortium
 - Consortium helpdesk for access problems


Projects

Project funding




The funding model requires contributions from the supported institutions which match the granted funding.


Research and use

- Joint standards for communication media and information skills

Digital content

- Development of pan-Swiss joint standards for communication media and information skills
- Retro-digitisation of old stock
- Permanent provision and availability of electronic journals, e-books, databases...

- enlargement of coverage among Swiss universities




From 2013
